POLICY ON TIMEFRAME FOR REGISTRATION FOR GRADUATES FROM COLLEGE OF MIDWIVES OF MANITOBA (CMM) APPROVED MIDWIFERY EDUCATION AND BRIDGING PROGRAMS

An applicant who is a graduate from a CMM approved midwifery education program, including a bridging program, must complete registration with the CMM within two years (24 months) from the date of graduation.

Should an applicant complete the registration process more than two years from the date of graduation from a CMM recognized midwifery education or bridging program, the applicant's clinical experience from the previous three years must be reassessed to determine if the applicant still meets the clinical experience requirements for registration as set out in the *Midwifery Regulation*. Applicants requiring reassessment of clinical experience are required to provide documentation of this experience to CMM, including but not limited to having their midwifery education program and a clinical reference who has observed their practice directly, verify their clinical experience for the three years prior to the date of application. An applicant who does not meet clinical experience requirements for registration as a practising midwife may be considered for Conditional Registration or may not be granted registration based on the assessment of the Board of Assessors.

This policy does not apply to an applicant who has registered with another Canadian midwifery regulator.
