PERINATAL REVIEW COMMITTEE CRITERIA FOR CASE REVIEW

Perinatal Mortality (≥ 500 grams)

All stillbirths

Neonatal/Infant death during the period of midwifery care

Perinatal Morbidity (≥ 1000 grams)

Five-minute Apgar ≤ 5

Seizures

Meconium aspiration with Apgar ≤ 7

Admission to NICU ≥ 36 weeks

Significant birth trauma

MATERNAL MORTALITY

The death of a woman known to be pregnant or within 42 days of delivery or termination of the pregnancy, irrespective of the duration of or site of the pregnancy.

MATERNAL MORBIDITY

Uterine rupture

Caesarean hysterectomy

Fistula involving the female genital tract

Admission to an Intensive Care Unit

Thrombo-embolic episode

Eclampsia

Postpartum return to caseroom/OR for operative management

Or other cases at the discretion of the midwife
